A personal interest is an interest that affects the Councillor more than most other people in the area. People include those who live, work or have property in the area of the Council. Councillors will also have a personal interest if their partner, relative or a close friend or organisation that they or the member works for is affected more than other people in the area. Whether an interest is prejudicial is a matter of judgement for each councillor. Would a member of the public who knew all the facts think that the Councillors interest was so important that their decision would be affected by it.
